## “SECOND ADVENT ATTITUDES”

Our culture begs the question, “God where are you?” How do we gain a supernatural perspective on life during these last days?

### I. ANOTHER INTERLUDE PRODUCES COMFORT! (10:1 – 11)

- John sees “another strong angel”
- There are 66 references to angels in the Book of Revelation
- Some believe this is Jesus. No and for several reasons:
  - John would have worshiped Him (1:17)
  - Jesus is never referred to as an angel in Revelation
  - “Another” in Greek means, “another of the same kind.”
  - This angel has just left the presence of the Lord

1<sup>st</sup>. His profile reminds of God’s glory! (10:1)

- He is “clothed with a cloud.”
- He has “a rainbow...upon his head.”
- His face “was shining like the sun.”
- His feet were “like pillars of fire.”

2<sup>nd</sup>. His posture reminds of God’s ownership! (10:2)

3<sup>rd</sup>. His proclamation reminds of God’s mercy! (10:3 – 4)

4<sup>th</sup>. His promise reminds of God's purpose! (10:5 – 7)

5<sup>th</sup>. His partnership reminds of our responsibility! (10:8 – 11)

**Second – Advent Attitudes**

- A. Live for Christ's coming. (Philippians 3:20)
- B. Wait for Christ's coming. (1 Thessalonians 1:10; 1 John 3:3)
- C. Believe His coming. (1 Thessalonians 4:14)
- D. Watch for His coming. (1 Thessalonians 5:6)
- E. Proclaim His coming. (2 Timothy 4:1 – 2)
- F. Love His coming. (2 Timothy 4:8)
- G. Look for His coming. (Titus 2:13)
